What's New in Dominican Republic:

- Punta Cana International Airport Announces New Upgrades | Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ), the busiest airports in the Caribbean, will be upgrading its technology and amenities to enhance inbound and outbound travel. These improvements include the implementation of Auto Gates for biometric passports and the introduction of Preclearance to speed up inspections and screenings. - Dominican Republic Cruise Season Off to a Strong Start | Dominican Republic has welcomed nearly 62,000 passengers and 16 cruise ships in the first four weeks of the official cruise season, according to Dominican Infotur. The country's main port, Amber Cove in Puerto Plata is set to receive more than six additional ships this month totaling nearly 25,000 passengers.
- New Hotel Brand Expected to Open in Santiago | Curio Collection by Hilton is expected to open in the fourth quarter of 2022 in Santiago, the second-largest city in the Dominican Republic.
