- Tourism Arrivals Up 4 Percent Compared to Last Year | The Central Bank of Dominican Republic announced that from January to June 2019 Dominican Republic welcomed 3.57 million tourists. This astounding number means Dominican Republic has seen a 4 percent growth in arrivals compared to the same time in 2018. According to the report 64 percent of those tourists arrived from North America making the country a top Caribbean destination for U.S. and Canadian travelers.
