What's new in Dominican Republic:

- Bávaro Beach Named Best in the World | A leading travel engine, TripAdvisor, recently released its Best Beaches of 2018 Travers' Choice Awards including Bávaro Beach, located along the east coast 25 minutes North of Punta Cana. - Dominican Republic Prepares to Welcome Spring Travelers | As families continue to seek adventure

The concert will return October 28 in Santo Domingo followed by a two-day series throughout Santiago and Puerto Plata with a two-day finale in Cabarete.
